We have resolved the billing error for the June Vineyards Utilities bill and a refund will be issued for our over-payment of an incorrect bill. This process has been a bit complicated because the Vineyards Utilities bills have not always shown up in the check registers for review.

The plan for the inner lake auto-fill is to move the auto-fill device and install a narrower housing cylinder for it in October after the rainy season. This should protect it from the currents in the water caused by the fill itself and the prevailing breeze on the lake. We will fine tune the fill level at that time as needed.

Solitude reported some algae in the inner lake in August and treated the lake accordingly. See attached monthly report from Solitude.

Cane toad tadpoles were seen in the inner lake in late August and at that time I asked for a quote from Solitude for the traps that were used 2 years ago. I have made two follow-up calls since then and we have still not received a quote. Our Solitude representative in both cases said that they have been extremely busy. At this point, we have missed the window for trapping this batch as they do not appear to be in the lake anymore. I will ask that the presence of tadpoles be reported in Solitude's monthly inspection.

I have just received a copy of the latest contract for Solitude signed by Cambridge. There are no changes in the contract since I raised the question regarding the lack of the liability addendum of previous contracts. I have to assume the board is OK with this.
